#### FROM PRESIDENT STRAITS

The South Haven Area Community Foundation is a vehicle for all of us to make a lasting difference in our South Haven community. The Foundation receives, pools, and invests funds from individuals, companies and other entities to support local non profits. A percentage of the earnings of endowed funds are annually determined to address local problems identified by the Board and local stakeholders. Contributors, like yourself, can also designate your donations be directed to a specific existing endowment managed by the Foundation (see list of endowment funds on the enclosed giving envelope) or as a donor you may request your contribution focus on immediate needs and not be endowed.

The Foundation has been growing in recent years particularly in the area of legacy giving. Individuals leave a portion of their estate to the Foundation with directions such as: this contribution is for South Haven student scholarships, or these funds should be used to sustain efforts of a non profit agency to assist the homeless.

The volunteer Board of Directors of the Foundation provides oversight and sets policy for investing funds, managing endowments, regulatory compliance, granting funds, and awarding scholarships. The Foundation is fully accredited by the Community Foundations National Standards Board and is audited annually by Kruggel Lawton. The Board has acquired and oversees the services of Zhang Financial as an Investment Consultant. Also, the Board has a relationship with The Berrien Community Foundation to provide accounting services.
